Audit Certificate Waiver Application

Electoral Act 1985 (SA) - Division 9, Part 13A

Purpose of this form

This form is to be completed by a person who is required to furnish a return under Part 13A of the *Electoral Act 1985* (the Act) and who seeks approval for the audit certificate requirement to be waived.

Legislative requirements
