

CITY OF TEA TREE GULLY

Review of Representation

Notice is hereby given that the City of Tea Tree Gully has reviewed its composition and elector representation arrangements in accordance with the requirements of Section 12 of the *Local Government Act 1999* (the Act).

Pursuant to Section 12(13)(a) of the Act, the Electoral Commissioner has issued a certificate that the review undertaken by Council satisfies the requirements of Section 12 of the Act and may now be put into effect as from the day of the first periodic election held after the publication of this notice.

The Council proposes to make no changes to its representation arrangements, with the following arrangement to take effect from polling day of the next periodic elections:

- The Principal Member of Council shall continue to be a Mayor, elected by the community as a representative of the area as a whole.
- The future elected body of Council will continue to comprise the Mayor and twelve (12) ward councillors.
- The Council area will continue to be divided into six (6) wards, as per the current ward structure, with each ward being represented by two (2) ward councillors.
- The wards will continue to be named/titled Pedare, Drumminor, Hillcott, Balmoral, Steventon and Water Gully.
