Recommended: From Year 8

Mock Election (45 Minutes)

This program can fit into a rotation schedule during an event. Session can include enrolling to vote, campaign speeches, voting, vote counting and declaration of result.

Pre event preparations essential.

Recommended: From Year 5

Democracy in Action (1 Hour)

A stand alone presentation or an introduction to your Civics and Citizenship unit. Content includes:

- Features of Australian Democracy

Learn how votes are counted using the preferential and proportional systems. This session takes students through the process of determining formal and informal ballots and how the distribution of preferences occurs for House of Assembly seats, as well as how quotas are determined and votes allocated in the Legislative Council.
